AFFIRMATION OF DAVID S. PREMINGER

1. I am a member of the law firm Keller Rohrback, L.L.P., attorneys of record for proposed intervenors Federal Home Loan Banks of Boston, Chicago and Indianapolis ("FHLB") in the above captioned action. I am familiar with the proceedings in this case and make this affirmation in support of the application to admit Amy Williams-Derry and Derek W. Loeser, partners in Keller Rohrback's Seattle, Washington office, as counsel pro hac vice to represent FHLB.

2. I am a member in good standing of the Bar of the State of New York and was admitted to practice law in 1973


3. I know from personal experience in working with Ms. Williams-Derry and Mr. Loeser that they are attorneys of the highest caliber and integrity.
